

The sensation created by the simple open weave appearance is particularly well-suited to a variety of commercial applications, but the warm color palette and subtle linear graphic may also find a home in residential designs seeking to infuse a lush, atmospheric quality.

St. Germain's four field tile sizes and variety of unique shapes allow for a multitude of patterning options, and the nine rich hues make the application possibilities incredibly diverse. An especially welcome inclusion is a unique 6" x 24" rectangular tile that can be placed randomly or in a dramatic grid pattern. Perhaps you may find that a decorative accent like the 1" x 2" mosaic, mesh-mounted for easy installation could be just the right touch for your design.

Let your imagination hopscotch through a few possibilities. What rooms might call for a subtle linear effect? Or an inner warmth? Which of these effects would be just the touch to make an interior or exterior wall, floor or countertop that much more inviting?

All sizes are completely modular with a rectified Tru Edge™ and useful finishing touches. A bullnose, cove base and cove corner are available in each color to complete any application you desire.







CLEANING PROCEDURES

- Remove loose dust and dirt with a damp cloth or sponge
- Use a neutral, non-abrasive cleaner suitable for ceramic tile
- Remove cleaning solution with a clean, damp sponge or mop

INSTALLATION METHODS BACKING MATERIALS

- Concrete
- Mortar bed
- Cementitious backer board

SETTING

- Latex modified thinset
- Epoxy

GROUTING

- Sanded grout
- Sanded cement grout
- Epoxy grout
- Recommended grout joint :1/16",
 1/8" when used in a modular pattern

Note: Since there are variations in all fired ceramic products, the tile and trim supplied for your particular installation may not match these samples. Final selection should be made from actual tiles and trim and not from tile and trim samples or color reproductions. For proper bonding, medium bed mortar should be utilized in installing tiles with a dimensional length size greater than 20" x 20", large rectangles or tiles with greater dimensional thickness than normal. Back buttering tiles of this nature in the installation process will also assure proper coverage for bonding.
